

Dear Churchill Borough Resident,

We are excited to announce that Churchill Borough has contracted with Waste Management as the exclusive trash and recycling hauler for residents.

As our team has demonstrated, we pride ourselves in providing the customer complete satisfaction. We are honored to be given this opportunity, and we are certain you will continue to be satisfied with the services you receive.

Many of your questions can be answered if you read the information below. However, contact our customer service department if you have additional questions.

New Bins!

The Borough will be using automated collection service for trash and recycling pick up. Bins will be delivered during the **week of December 18**, and all residents will receive the **Standard** package (65-gallon trash bin and 65-gallon recycling bin) unless you contacted Waste Management to select from the bin menu you received in November. Waste Management will provide one bin selection change after the first quarter of 2018. All changes must be submitted by March 1, 2018.

Residential Services:

Please place your trash and recycling curbside after 6:00pm the night prior to your scheduled collection to ensure un-interrupted service. Please make sure material is visible and within three feet of the curb. Service times may vary depending on operational issues, weather, etc. Trash and recycling will be collected with an automated collection arm and must be placed in supplied automated bins. No material outside of the bin will be collected.

Please make sure trash and recycling bins are placed at least 3-feet apart and away from any parked cars, mail boxes or low hanging wires. Lids should close to ensure effective robotic collection.



Recycling Services:



Recycling will be collected curbside bi-weekly. Please see attached schedule for your service week.

Recyclable material must be placed in your recycling collection bin, which is green with a yellow lid. Do not bag recyclables. Please do not mix regular household trash with recyclables.

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING MATERIALS: pourable plastic and glass containers with the Mobius symbol on the bottom (ex. plastic soda bottles, plastic milk jugs, etc.), glass jars and bottles, newspaper and other office paper, phone books, paperboard, cartons, aluminum and steel cans and cardboard.

UNACCEPTABLE RECYCLING MATERIALS: Plastic grocery bags and other film plastic, styrofoam (even if it has the Mobius symbol), rubber hoses, wire, containers with residual food or beverage, etc.

At Your Door Special Collection ProgramSM

Effective January 1, 2018, Waste Management will offer a convenient service in Churchill Borough for residents to properly dispose and recycle home-generated special materials- safely, easily, and responsibly. These items may include paints, household cleaners, compact fluorescent lamps (CFL), automotive products, garden chemicals, batteries, electronics, and more. This program is built in to your quarterly bill and there will be no additional charge to participate.

To participate, you must set up a collection appointment.

The Call Center operators will guide you through the steps toward a safe and successful collection. A kit will be sent to your home in plenty of time for you to gather and pack your materials. You will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of materials available for collection. You will be provided a convenient collection date and information about where to place the HHW kit for collection.

On the scheduled date, the customer service technician will collect materials directly from your home. They will sort and pack the materials for proper transportation, recycling and disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail back to help track the program.

The materials accepted through this program include:



Automotive products

Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels and more



Garden Chemicals

Fertilizers, herbicides, insect sprays, pesticides and weed killers



Household Chemicals

Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaners, naval jelly, strippers and tile remover



Paint Products

Caulk, glue, paint, stripper, stain, thinner, and wood preservative



Electronics

TVs, computers, monitors, keyboards, DVD players, VHS players, microwaves and cell phones



Swimming Pool Chemicals

Chlorine tablets and liquid, pool acid and stabilizer



Universal materials

Batteries, lamps, thermometers and more

We do not collect ammunition, explosives, asbestos, tires, or any materials in unlabeled or leaking containers. For program details, contact (800) 449-7587.

Yard Waste and Leaf Collection:

Throughout the year, residents may place bagged grass and shrub clippings, garden residue, weeds and short tree branch clippings in their trash bin (green lid). **Leaves will not be accepted for collection in your trash or recycling bin.**

Yard waste and leaf waste is a special collection and will be provided on select dates. Please reference the attached calendar for the 2018 pick up schedule.

During these special collection days, yard waste, including leaves, may be placed at the curb in biodegradable bags to be collected by Waste Management or Churchill Borough. On the days designated as "Leaf Collection", **only leaves** will be accepted at the curb in biodegradable bags.

Christmas trees can be placed at the curb and will be collected on your scheduled pick up day through the end of January. After January 30th, trees will only be accepted as a bulk item during your monthly bulk collection day.

Bulk Goods Policy

Bulk pick-up days will be the first Tuesday of the month. Residents are permitted to dispose of two bulk items outside of the bin on the scheduled bulk collection days.

If you have more than two items per scheduled pick up day, or would like a bulk item collected on a day outside of the scheduled day, please call Waste Management customer service at 1-800-866-4460 so that we can schedule employees and equipment to appropriately handle the item/s being picked up. We will also review pricing and/or prepayment.

Bulk pick up includes household furniture and large appliances; including but not limited to the following: refrigerators (with the Freon properly removed), washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, bicycles, microwaves, carpet (3-foot section, 40lbs or less) etc.

Bulk goods pick up **does not include** the following: yard waste, tree stumps, trimmings, construction or demolition materials, flood or fire debris, remodeling waste, auto parts, or any other non-household item.

- Refrigerators and freezers must have doors removed.
- Freon containing appliances must have the Freon removed by a certified technician with the proper documentation attached. **THE ITEM WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF THE FREON HAS BEEN DISCHARGED ILLEGALLY.** If you need Freon removal service, please contact WM customer service in advance of your pick up to make arrangements. Please note an additional fee will be charged.

Payment Options

With WM EZPay, you can pay quickly and securely through Waste Management's private website and make your transactions with a variety of payment options. All you need to get started is a copy of your invoice. Just visit www.wm.com for more information. Look for the link to WM EZPay.

- Residents will be billed quarterly
- Pay via checking account, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express at www.wm.com
- Payments can also be mailed to the address on your payment coupon. Payment is due upon receipt of the invoice and will be posted within 14 days

All leaf and yard waste must be placed in biodegradable bags. Trash must be placed in your bin with the green lid, no material outside of the bin will be collected. Recyclables must be placed in your bin with the yellow lid, no material outside of the bin will be collected.


