Public Hearing – Ordinance No. 750

August 5, 2019

A Public Hearing of the Council of the Borough of Churchill was held in the Municipal Building on Monday, August 5, 2019 and was called to order by Mr. Dworin at 7:05 p.m. Members present included Mses. Law, Greco and Yankes, Messrs. Collins, DeFranco, McDowell and Mayor Gamrat. Also present were Borough Manager/Secretary Donna J. Perry and Solicitor Gavin Robb.

Mr. Dworin along with Mr. Robb gave a brief description of the proposed Ordinance No. 750.

Lafe Metz – 301 Grant Street, Pittsburgh was here representing the Hillwood Development Company. He has concerns with the zoning amendment and was here to object the passing of it.

Carl Rothenberger – 1720 Williamsburg Place talked about the strong potential benefits to this project.

Lowell Mate – 27 Churchill Road said that as a member of the Planning Commission he is questioning the proposed ordinance and asking what it would accomplish.

R.F. Culbertson – 17 Churchill Road spoke about the proposed ordinance.

Charles DiLereto – 247 Marshall Road is a partner in Churchill Crossings. He spoke about the use of the former Westinghouse facility.

Wende Mate – 27 Churchill Road spoke about the proposed ordinance.

Adam Hanson – 2020 Reese Run Road of Churchill Crossing said he wanted to redevelop the community and asked us not to shut this down by rezoning this area.

Ken Balkey – 2007 Hampstead Drive asked if Westinghouse was able to remain at this site.
