

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHURCHILL, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROHIBITING THE DEPOSIT OF SNOW AND ICE UPON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, AND WAYS OF THE BOROUGH AND THE PARKING OR STANDING OF VEHICLES UPON STREETS, ALLEYS AND WAYS OF THE BOROUGH WHICH PREVENT OR INTERFERE WITH THE REMOVAL OR PLOWING OF SNOW AND CLEANING OF STREETS; AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF SAID VEHICLES AND THE SETTING OF PENALTIES AND FINES FOR SAID ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the free movement of traffic in the Borough of Churchill, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania is at times impeded because of careless parking or standing vehicles at the time of removal or plowing of snow. Also the depositing of snow and ice on public ways.

WHEREAS, a dangerous condition exists at such times on the streets, and highways of said Borough.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Churchill, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Definitions:

(a) The term "Nuisance", for the purposes of this ordinance, shall include, but not limited to, the depositing of snow and ice on public ways, or the parking or leaving standing any vehicle on the streets or highways in the Borough of Churchill, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania at such time as to prevent or interfere with the removal or plowing of snow and the cleaning of streets.

(b) "Individual" shall mean any person, persons, partnership, firm, company, corporation, or other association.

(c) The term "notice" for the purposes of authorizing the removal of a vehicle by a towing firm shall mean the placing by a Borough employee of written notice upon the vehicle.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any individual to park or leave standing any vehicle upon any street or highway in the Borough of Churchill, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, in such a way or at such a time as to interfere with the removal or the plowing of snow or cleaning of streets.

SECTION 3. No individual shall place, deposit, dump, shovel, or cause any placement, depositing, dumping, or shoveling of snow or ice on to any Borough street, road, alley, or way.


SECTION 4. Any vehicle upon which proper notice has been placed and which has not been removed by the owner thereof within one (1) hour of said posting of notice may be removed and all charges incurred in such removal, including but not limited to towing of said vehicle and storage thereof, shall be paid by the owner of said vehicle.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective from September 15 to the following April 30.

SECTION 6. ENFORCEMENT PENALTIES: Any individual, partnership, or corporation who or which shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars. In default of payment of the fine, such person, the members of such partnership, or the officers of such corporation shall be liable to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation is continued shall constitute a separate offense.
